Questions to Academia

How did civil society engagement and political culture change in light of the rise of the extreme right in Poland and Germany in recent years?

This especially includes the issues of prevention of right-wing extremism, racism, and anti-Semitism, right-wing extremist violence, the rule of law, and changes in the media landscape.

Questions to Civil Society

I am interested in exchanging ideas with civil society activists in Poland about activism against right-wing extremism, racism, and anti-Semitism. In particular, I would like to know what impact the PiS government has had on their activism.

We are planning an educational trip to Poland in 2027 with activists from Brandenburg on the topic of civil society under a right-wing government. I am interested in contacts for meetings and discussions.

Questions to (Political) Decision-Makers

How can civil society be protected from attacks and defamation by right-wing extremists? How can civil society activism be supported from within the opposition under a right-wing or nationalist government? What are the political practices of right-wing extremists and right-wing populists in parliament and in public? What similarities and differences exist in Germany and Poland?
