Current (Research) Project

Cognitive Defence Fund is an Kybernetes Institute initiative bringing together knowledge (fundamentals) and resources (funds) to build social and cognitive resilience. Its operational tool is to be **Anansi Web** – a system for modelling the information domain, tracking narratives, and reporting influence operations. A Kybernetes representative participates in the work of the Polish **MFA Resilience Council** and collaborates on the concept of a **Youth Resilience Council**, where knowledge from CDF and technological work may undergo operationalisation.
